Network adheres to the Evangelical Alliance doctrine of faith, whilst trying to set our faith in the context of the current UK culture.






We are a church built around small groups

Our main emphasis is on the midweek small groups which meet across St Albans and Harpenden, and which together make up the church as a whole.

These groups are where the life of the body of Christ happens: prayer and ministry, small group worship, sharing and community, and reaching out to our non-Christian friends and families.



The values which underpin our style of church are A, B, C, D, E:-

- Becoming disciples (everybody growing)
- Creating community (sharing and support)
- Doing evangelism (reaching out to non-Christian friends & family)
